

James Tonic Releases "Us Two," a Melancholic Dream Pop Ballad Out Now

Out August 6, 2026. The new solo single opens the road to the Safety Tour, a staged dream pop musical touring 18 cities this winter.

NEW YORK, NY. Drummer Records announces "Us Two," the new solo single from James Tonic, available everywhere August 6, 2026. An emotional ballad built on layered vocal harmonies, warm synth textures, and soft strings, "Us Two" captures romance and drama in the same breath, drawing early comparisons from curators and radio programmers to Fleetwood Mac, Mild High Club, and Beach House. The release follows the singles "Who's Going Down" and "How It Goes" and the albums Safety and Safety II, in a catalog with over 500 million streams across platforms.

Within days of release, "Us Two" was picked up by independent playlists, radio programs, and music press across North America, Europe, and Latin America. The single marks the beginning of a new era: this winter James Tonic brings the Safety albums to the stage as the Safety Tour, a dream pop musical presented in seated theatres, running December 6, 2026 through February 14, 2027 across 18 cities.
